- 5 All plants, fruit, vegetable, flowers and compost must be bone-fide exhibitors' own produce or in their possession at least two months before the show, except in classes 45 to 49. The Committee shall have the right to inspect any exhibits after entries have been received.
- 6 No exhibitor may be awarded more than one prize in any one class.
- 7 The Committee shall have the right to inspect any exhibits after entries have been received.
- 8 All prize money to be claimed after presentation of cups.
- 9 All exhibits to be staged by **11:00am on Saturday 1st September 2007.**
The Parish Hall will be open from **8:00am.**
- 10 Exhibits to remain on show until after presentation of cups.
- 11 The Judges will be empowered to make an inferior or no award when exhibits do no in their opinion possess sufficient merit or when the number of entries are not sufficient.
- 12 In sections B&C only one prize will be awarded to entries from the same allotment or garden.
- 13 Prize winners to return cups to Hon Sec not later than 1 August 2008.
- 14 **No exhibit may be moved except by stewards**
